1st City-HUB Stakeholder Workshop

The 1st City-HUB Workshop will take place in Budapest on 21 March 2013. The topic of this Workshop is “**Identifying Key Intermodality Factors**”. The workshop aims to identify perceived gaps and further research and policy needs with respect to the practical delivery of good practice in interchanges. Key experts in the domain will attend the event to discuss with City-HUB partners crucial issues related to interchange design and operations. It will then synthesise and report on the state-of-the-art-knowledge and describe any identified policy responses to this in the European context and beyond.
